The **Kutullo Electrification Project** exemplifies this commitment. For many years, households in Kutullo Village near Steelpoort, Limpopo, lived without access to reliable electricity, limiting educational opportunities, economic development and overall quality of life. Access to basic services remained a significant challenge for the community and contributed to ongoing social and service delivery frustrations.

Recognising electricity as a critical enabler of social and economic development, Glencore Eastern Chrome Mines embarked on a major electrification project in partnership with key stakeholders.

The project included:

- Construction of new overhead electrical distribution infrastructure.
- Installation of additional substations.
- Expansion of the local electricity network.
- Ongoing collaboration with the national service provider to support future electrification growth.

With a total investment of **R50 million**, the project successfully connected **1,200 previously unconnected households** to the electricity grid, bringing safe and reliable power to families who had lived without this essential service.

The benefits have been transformative. Households now enjoy improved living conditions, enhanced safety, better opportunities for learners to study after dark, and increased potential for local entrepreneurship and economic participation. Reliable electricity has become a catalyst for growth and development, significantly improving the wellbeing of the community.

The Kutululo Electrification Project represents far more than physical infrastructure. It is an investment in people, opportunity and dignity. It demonstrates how collaborative partnerships and responsible mining can address critical community needs while creating sustainable and measurable social impact.

By enabling access to electricity for 1,200 households, Glencore Eastern Chrome Mines

has helped power a better future for the residents of Kutululo Village and reinforced its commitment to creating lasting value beyond mining.
